2010 Eden Valley Riesling

Eden Valley skirts the eastern slopes of the Barossa Ranges, and is known for crisp floral Rieslings. A sub-region of the Barossa, Eden Valley is a place of rugged beauty.

The cool climate provides ideal conditions for high quality Rieslings giving mineral, lime and citrus flavours.

The Winter Creek Eden Valley Riesling is vibrant and aromatic with hints of rose-petal and subtle fennel, leading to enticing crisp green apple and citrus flavours with a balanced acid finish.

A wonderful wine that will drink well when young, or will age perfectly with good cellaring.

Winemaking

Hand picked from the High Eden Ridge vineyard in the cool of the night and quickly transported to the winery, the Winter Creek Eden Valley Riesling is made from only the free run portion of the pickings. The juice is fermented at cool temperatures using aromatic yeasts.

Upon completion of fermentation, bottling occurs quickly to ensure freshness is maintained.

Vintage

A traditional wet winter in the Eden Valley saw the first non drought conditions for many years. Mild conditions were maintained right through the growing season right up to harvest.
